Changes in the State Assessment

2010

- Raised cut scores for Level 2 and Level 3 Proficiency
- Included 25 to 30 percent more tested performance indicators on the Math assessment
- Added audit items

2011-2013

- Increase length of Math and ELA tests
- Test more new performance indicators
- Make test items more difficult to predict
- Improve quality of English Regents exam

2014-2015

- Student achievement expectations are based on CCSS and state standards as added.

Assessments Changes in 2011

- Broader and deeper content coverage:
 - Questions will not be released, making tests less predictable and ensuring more comprehensive student readiness
 - More multiple choice questions, to better measure ranges of student performance
 - More essay writing on Grades 3, 5 & 7 English Language Arts exams
- External research and review conducted by the State Education Department.

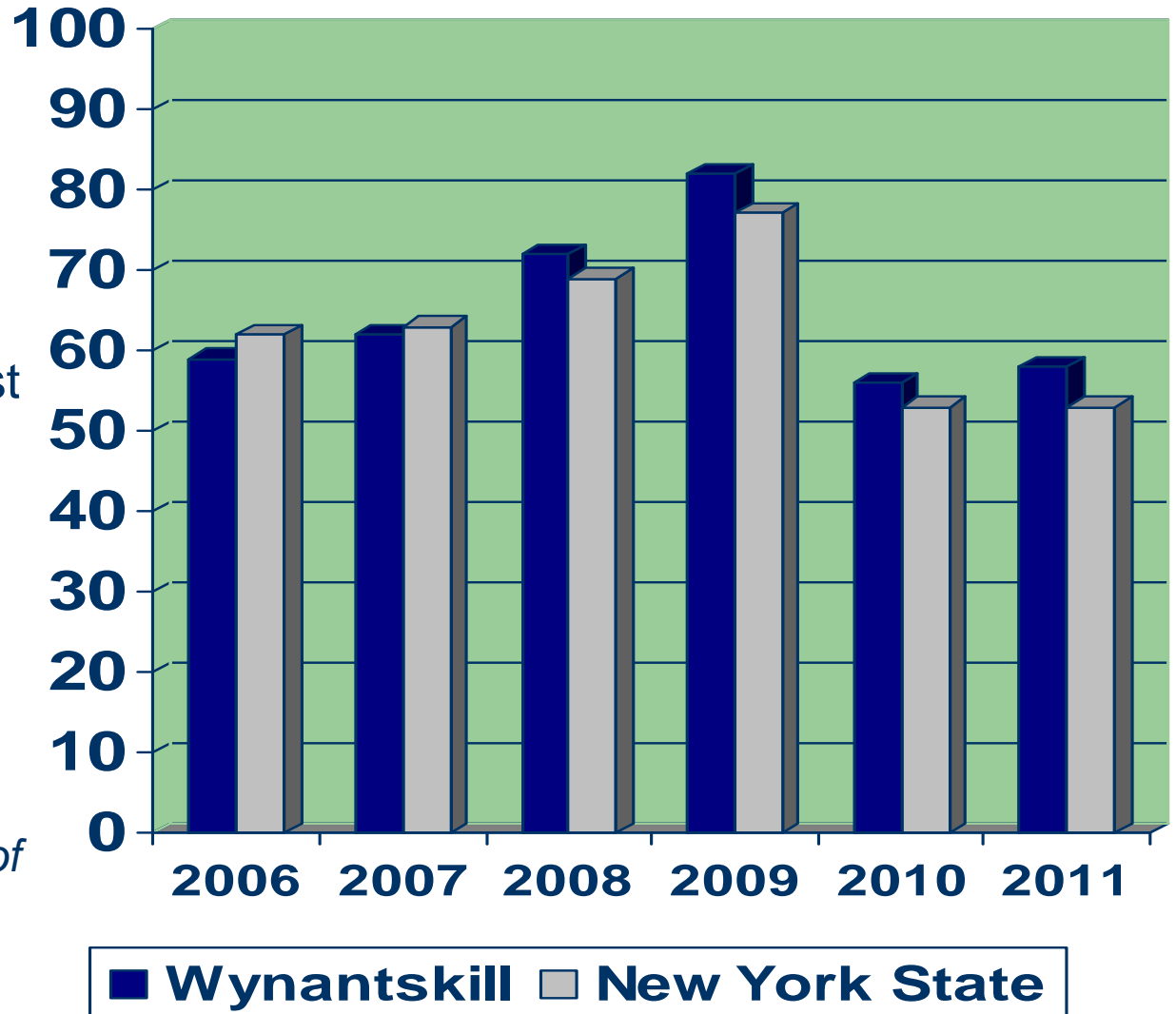

How Do We Improve?

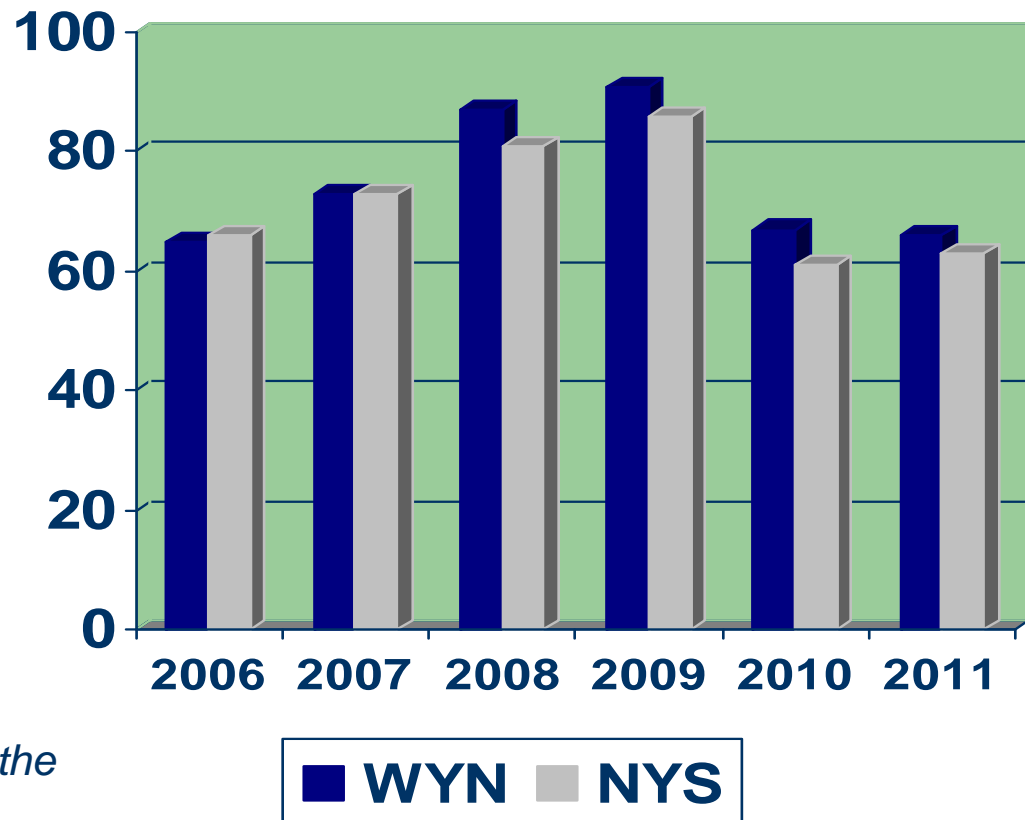
- Continue targeted staff development for our ELA program

What Does the Data Tell Us?

- *The bar is now set higher, rules have changed.*
- The change in higher cut scores have resulted in fewer students scoring at a 'Proficient level'.
- We have improved our quality scale scores.
- We are seeing strength in the quality of our program and achievement performance at several grade levels.
- Required RTI interventions for Math has been reduced by 1/3.
- Required RTI interventions for ELA are static.
- Special Education results are not moving.
- Overall mastery (level 4) achievement in both ELA and Math is below the state average,

Next Steps....

- We will further analyze the data on individual students, group cohort and grade level progress.
- We will again conduct gap analysis work in order to assess our achievement progress and to identify instructional gaps.
- District goals developed with specific achievement targets based on the data.
