# 2.0 Reports to the Board of Education

# 2.1 District / School Program Report

- a. Common Core Mr. Bordick gave a follow up on the Common Core and the issues discussed at HVCC. Mr. Bordick touched based on the standardized curriculum, how students compete nationally, and are students being college and career ready. Mr. Bordick spoke on how testing would be used to evaluate students and teachers and how vendors would be able to take data and the privacy of the student.
- **Resolution on testing** Many NYS school boards are adopting resolutions to show our concerns on the Common Core Testing. Mr. Bordick spoke on the random field testing and making sure parents are informed on the options. Mr. Hug asked what the purpose of the resolution is. Mr. Bordick stated that it is basically to be united with other school districts nationwide. Mrs. Paone wanted to know if in general there were other options for testing and assessments available. Mr. Bordick explained that the school district cannot get access to the exams due to State providing an outside vendor to handle the testing process. The board would like to support the resolution and send a letter to show support. The resolution will be added to the end of the agenda number 3.15.
- c. Strategic Planning Committee Update The first meeting will be on January 9, 2014 at 6:30 pm. Parents, teachers, community members and board members will all be part of the 22 people on the committee.
- **d.** Staffing Overview Annual Staffing overview should be updated closer to budget time
- e. **Tuition 2013-2014** Mr. Bordick will be working with Amy Murphy and the five school choices for our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students to have a high school career day and we will be still having the shadow day before they have to make a decision. The board would like feedback on how our students are doing in each of the four schools. The board did also look closely at the tuition rates between the four schools.
- f. Regional State Budget Event Thursday January 30 South Colonie High School Local schools, State assembly, State senate groups will be discussing the Common Core. Mr. Bordick felt the event will be well attended.

#### 3.15 Resolution:

WHEREAS, The Wynantskill Union Free School District is dedicated provide opportunities for all students to reach their fullest potential; empower all to achieve personal excellence and encourage a life-long love of learning: and

WHEREAS, the decline in state support for public schools has forced our District to reduce programs and limited our ability to implement the new programs mandated by the state such as the Common Core Standards, creating an uneven rollout of the standards among school districts around the state; and

WHEREAS, while the implementation of Common Core will ultimately help students, teachers, and teaching and learning, the growing reliance on and misalignment of standardized testing is eroding student learning time, narrowing the curriculum, and jeopardizing the rich, meaningful education our students need and deserve; and

WHEREAS, despite the fact that research recommends the use of multiple measures to gauge student performance and teacher effectiveness, the state's growing reliance on standardized testing is adversely affecting students across all spectrums, as well as the morale of our educators and further draining already scarce resources; and

WHEREAS, the federal elementary and secondary education act's testing policies fail to appropriately accommodate the unique needs of students with disabilities and English language learners in assessing their learning, resulting in test scores that do not accurately represent a true measure of the contributions of teachers and schools; and

WHEREAS, it is time for policymakers to recalibrate the number, duration, and appropriate use of standardized tests so that we can refocus our efforts on student learning; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that we call upon the Commissioner of Education, the NYS Board of Regents, and other policymakers to reduce the use of and over-reliance on standardized testing; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that we call upon the U.S. Congress and the Administration to reduce federal testing mandates and support the role of and focus on multiple measures of student learning and school quality in accountability systems.
