

WHEN TO REQUEST TEMPORARY REMOTE LEARNING

We would like to clarify that families should only request that their child use the remote learning option, instead of physically attending school, for one of the following reasons:

- The student is staying home due to illness *yet feels up to fully participating in class.*
- The student is awaiting the results of a COVID-19 Test.
- The student has been directed to quarantine for a period of time.

Students can not just decide to stay home and participate remotely if they are not doing so for the reasons listed above, or some other extenuating circumstance.

If your child feels sick and does not feel well enough to actively participate in class, it is not necessary to log into remote learning. Your child will be marked absent due to illness like any other year. If they feel up to doing some class work, please check Google Classroom for posted assignments.
